



Prepositions – City Living

Transportation

IN

Use **IN** for private transportation

in a car, in a truck, in a taxi, in an Uber, in a small boat, in a canoe, in a kayak

ON

Use **ON** for public transportation

on the bus, on a plane, on a ship, on a cruise, on a train, on the train, on the tram

ALSO, use **ON** for things that one person can sit or stand on to ride

on a bike, on a motorcycle, on a horse, on a surfboard, on a skateboard, on a Segway

AT

Use **AT** for places where you wait for transport

at the bus stop, at the taxi rank, at the airport, at the train station

Locations

IN

IN is for enclosed spaces, places with borders or boundaries like rooms, town cities, countries or continents

on Broadway, on the Mexican border, on the first floor, on 10th Avenue

ON

Use **ON** for surfaces

on the ground, on the floor, on the wall, on the beach (if your tanning!)

AT

Use **AT** for specific locations, places of business and stores

at the supermarket, at the beach, at the library, at the zoo, at the restaurant, at the mall
